Monthly Missions Spotlight

Awareness: She's Somebody's Daughter (SSD) offers informative Human Trafficking 101 & Internet Safety training to youth and adults in school, professional, church, and community settings. Their interactive simulation, **Take a Walk in Their Shoes**, allows a glimpse into the life of a trafficked young woman, illustrating the lack of viable choices and trauma present in an exploited life.

Outreach: Their goal in outreach is simply to build relationships and offer a support system. SSD goes to motels, strip clubs, homeless encampments, drug and alcohol recovery centers, prisons, message businesses and reaches out online to connect with those who may be affected by or vulnerable to the commercial sex industry. By offering warmth, small gifts, and necessities, we initiate relationships and share God's love with those affected by commercial sexual exploitation.

Community: Women transitioning out of the commercial sex industry can connect with community resource partners for physical needs as well as enter into a widening circle of relationships that celebrate every step towards healing and life goals. They also have the opportunity to join in therapeutic programming, such as "Ending the Game" to learn about traffickers coercive tactics.

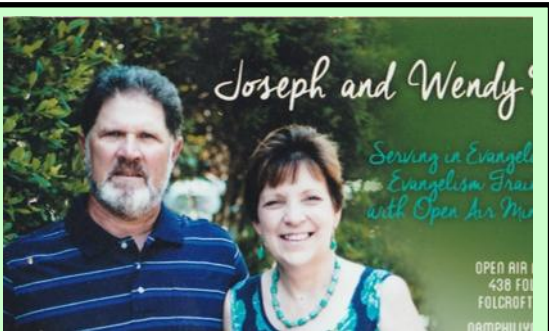

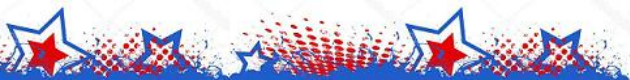
