Dear Clarks Valley Zion family,

If I haven't had the joy of meeting you yet, my name is Abbey Hagopian. I grew up attending and participating in various youth programs at CVZ. I am currently away finishing my freshman year at Gettysburg College, where I am studying Environmental Studies and Education. I'm excited to share that I will be stepping into camp ministry again this summer as part of Camp Hebron's summer staff, serving as the Leaders-in-Training (LIT) Director. As the LIT Director, I will mentor and disciple all Staff-in-Training, Counselors-in-Training, Wranglers-in-Training, and any staff under the age of 18 while also serving on leadership team for all summer staff. I will be at Camp from late May through early August. It will be a full summer of learning, service, fun, and ministry! I'll be working alongside other young adults to share the Gospel, build relationships with campers, and connect with families throughout the summer.

I am excited about this opportunity because church camp has been a deeply formative part of my life. It's where my faith became personal, and I am eager to witness campers and staff alike come to know Jesus this summer. This will be my fourth summer on staff, and I'm so thankful for how the Lord has grown me each year. I know this summer will challenge me in new ways, but I'm expectant that God will use those challenges to grow me and to work through me in the lives of others.

I'm writing to ask if you would consider partnering with me in my work, service, and ministry this summer. Building the Kingdom of God is most effectively done through community, and I would greatly value having your prayers and support. There are a few ways that I'd like to invite you to join me:

1. Please pray for me, our campers, and our staff this summer! Prayer is powerful, effective, and an essential part of our ministry.

3. Prayerfully consider supporting me financially through the Summer Staff Support Fund. My goal is to raise \$2,500 to supplement my summer stipend. As a college student, committing to a summer of service comes with real financial challenges, but I'm stepping forward in faith, encouraged by 1 John 5:14: "And this is the confidence that we have toward Him, that if we ask anything according to His will He hears us." I have seen the Lord provide for me before, and I trust that He will provide for me again in this season. Your support and generosity would allow me to focus fully on the work God has called me to this summer.

I'm looking forward to connecting with you and sharing more about my summer experience at Camp Hebron! Please, let me know if you have any questions. Thank you for your time and consideration.

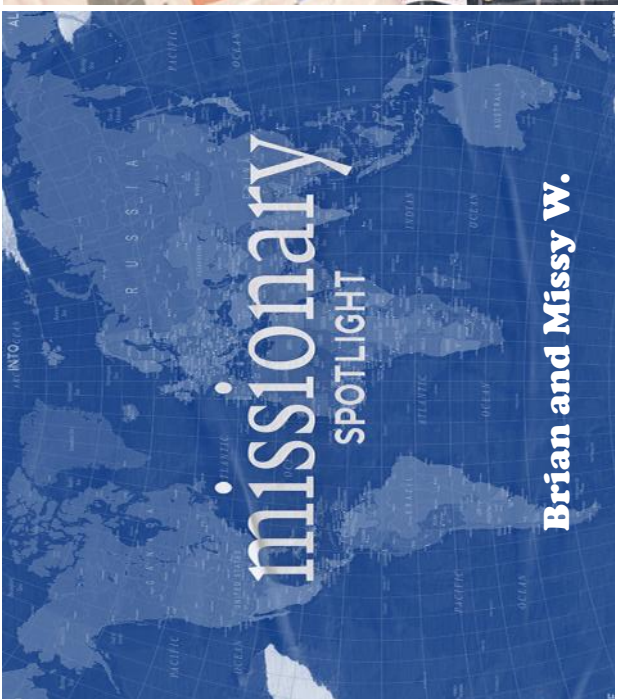
